

Data Protection Declaration SteelCERT GmbH

The protection of your personal data is of particular concern to us. We therefore process your data exclusively on the basis of the legal provisions (DSGVO, TKG 2003). In this data protection information we inform you about the most important aspects of data processing within the scope of our website.

Contact with us

If you contact us using the form on the website or by e-mail, the data you provide will be saved with us for six months for the purpose of editing your request and for the case of follow-up questions. This data we do not pass on without your consent.

Data storage

We would like to indicate that for the purpose of a simpler registration process / purchasing process and for later contract processing within the framework of cookies, the IP data of the subscriber is stored, as well as the name, address and credit card number [...] of the buyer. In addition, for the purpose of contract processing, the following data is also stored with us: employer, name, contact details and comments made available. The data, made available by you, is required for the fulfillment of the contract or to carry out pre-contractual measures. Without this data, we cannot conclude the contract with you. There is no data transfer to third parties, except for the transfer of the credit card data to the processing bank / payment service provider for the purpose of debiting the purchase price, to the transport company / shipping company commissioned by us to deliver the goods as well as to our tax consultant to fulfill our tax obligations. After canceling the registration process / purchasing process, the data stored with us will be deleted. In the event of a conclusion of a contract, all data from the contractual relationship will be saved until the expiry of the tax retention period (7 years). The data name, address, purchased goods, booked course units and date of purchase, beyond that, are stored until the end of the product liability (10 years). The data processing happens on the basis of the legal provisions of § 96 Abs 3 TKG as well as Art 6 Par 1 lit a (consent) and / or lit b (necessary to fulfill the contract) of the GDPR.

Cookies

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your device with the help of the browser. They do no harm. We use cookies to make our offer user-friendly. Some cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. They enable us to recognize your browser the next time you visit. If you do not want this, you can set up your browser in such a way that it informs you about the setting of cookies and you only allow this in individual cases. When deactivating cookies, the functionality of our website may be restricted.

Web analysis

Our website uses functions of a web analysis service. For this purpose, cookies are used, which allow an analysis of the use of the website by the users. The information generated in this way is transferred to the provider's server and saved there.

You can prevent this by setting up your browser in such a way that no cookies are saved.

We have concluded a corresponding contract for order-data processing with the provider.

The data processing happens on the basis of the legal provisions of § 96 Par. 3 TKG as well as Par. 6 Abs 1 lit a (Consent) and / or f (legitimate interest) of the GDPR.

Our concern within the meaning of the GDPR (legitimate interest) is the improvement of our offer and our web appearance. Since the privacy of our users is important to us, the user data is pseudonymized [pseudonymization is recommended for the legal reason "legitimate interest"; this must be clarified with the web analysis service].
